LET'S TALK ABUNDANCE

Invisible Assets – Part 3 "Endurance"

John 10:10 TPT

A thief has only one thing in mind—he wants to steal, slaughter, and destroy. But I have come to give you everything in abundance, more than you expect—life in its fullness until you overflow!

Bible patience is NOT a toleration of unfavorable conditions, but rather it is the act of ENDURANCE. The

will of God cannot be fully accomplished in your life unless there is a resilience to adhere to "bible

patience". When you're operating in endurance, you don't "put up with it" regarding adverse conditions

because in faith you have the power to change conditions and circumstances (Matthew 16:9).

Ecclesiastes 11:4 - KJV ⁴ He that observeth the wind shall not sow; and he that regardeth the clouds shall not reap.

INHERITING THE PROMISE OF ABUNDANCE

Hebrews 6:12 - AMPC

¹² In order that you may not grow disinterested and become [spiritual] sluggards, but imitators, behaving as do those who through faith (^[a]by their leaning of the entire personality on God in Christ in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom, and goodness) and by practice of patient endurance and waiting are [now] inheriting the promises.

You inherit the promise of God's abundance by your faith and your patience [endurance]. This
keeps you from quitting and fainting in your minds when things are not happening the way you
think they should be happening.

LACKING NOTHING

James 1:4 - AMPC

⁴ But let endurance and steadfastness and patience have full play and do a thorough work, so that you may be [people] perfectly and fully developed [with no defects], lacking in nothing.

Endurance makes perfect [complete, whole, and fully developed]. When enduring you <u>persevere</u>:
 (1) stay true to the Work God spoke to you, (2) stay out of your past, and (3) keep embracing the vision for your future. These steps will cause you to constantly see your abundance.

MANIFESTATION IS THE OUTCOME OF PATIENCE

Luke 8:15 - AMPC

¹⁵ But as for that [seed] in the good soil, these are [the people] who, hearing the Word, hold it fast in a just (^[a]noble, virtuous) and worthy heart, and steadily bring forth fruit with patience.

• You will bear the fruit of your abundance with you master patient endurance.

Hebrews 10:36 - AMPC ³⁶ For you have need of steadfast patience and endurance, so that you may perform and fully accomplish the will of God, and thus receive and ^[a]carry away [and enjoy to the full] what is promised.
